

For conflicts of €200 or less:

## CONFLICT NOTIFICATION

The Legal and Licensing Department of AGICOA notifies a conflict of €200 or less pertaining to a declared work (art. 9(1)\*).

## 180 DAYS

Parties have 180 days to resolve the conflict through direct negotiations and amend their declarations accordingly or to inform AGICOA of their intention to start legal proceedings, arbitration or mediation (art. 9\*).

When the conflict is solved, retained royalties are distributed to the entitled party(ies) (art. 9(3)\*, 9(4b)\*).

Within 180 days, parties may inform AGICOA of their intention to initiate legal proceedings, arbitration or mediation. AGICOA will then proceed to [phase 4 of conflict resolution procedure \(art. 9\(4c\)\\*](#)).

Failure to actively engage in negotiation or to inform AGICOA about the settlement terms within deadline will lead to rights withdrawal (art. 9(2)\*, 9(4a)\*).
