1 Scope

This document explains in detail the format of the import quality check file that will be issued after an import of data into AGICOA / IRRIS (import confirmations, warnings or errors).

Import quality check information are exchanged with AGICOA for the following processes:

- Result of importing Broadcasts in format BRD;
- Result of importing Works and Rights in format WRI;
- Result of importing External Conflicts in format CFT

2 Characteristics

This document details the format for import quality check data in accordance to the principles defined in the "IS&T procedure - Import/Export Process" document.

The exchange file is thus made of:

- a block header (containing the message reference and version number);
- a block content (described further in this document);
- a block footer.

1.1 Import Quality Check Header example

Field content:

- **Version** will contain the message version and reference
- **FromCompany** will contain AGICOA Geneva
- **FromPerson** will contain the responsible person that will treat the data received in AGICOA
- **ToCompany** will contain the company AGICOA is sending the IQC file to
- **ToPerson** will contain the responsible person that will receive the file
- **BegDate** is the date of the import process
- **BegTime** is the time of the import process
- **Extension** will contain the file that has been imported, related to this IQC file

These informations are helpful to know to what file that IQC file is related to.

Here is an example of the header that will be in an IQC file:

1.2 Import Quality Check Footer example

Field content:

- **RecCount** will contain the number of IQC record in the IQC file
- **EndDate** is the date of end of the import process
- **EndTime** is the time of end of the import process

Here is an example of the footer that will be in an IQC file:

RecCount : 2467
EndDate : 2003/05/19
EndTime : 09:21:17

This standard data exchange for import quality check is identified by the following message reference and version number:

4 Block content

1.3 General characteristics of an import quality check record

#	Data field	Format	Description
1	Reference (Sender)	Text (max. 20)	Mandatory. Must be the sender reference of the record imported. If the format is WRI, a work reference sender. If the format is BRD a broadcast reference sender.
2	Feedback Category	Text (fix 1)	Mandatory. Describes if the record is a warning (a non fatal error occurred), an error (a fatal error occurred), or a feedback that no fatal error occurred and the record is ok. So the category codes are: 0 = Record Ok 1 = Warning 2 = Error 3 = information;
3	Reference (Receiver)	Text (max. 20)	Optional. Must be the AGICOA reference of the record imported, if a record was created. If the format is WRI, the AGICOA declaration reference of the newly imported record (if no fatal error has occurred). If the format is BRD, the AGICOA broadcast reference of the newly imported record (if no fatal error has occurred).
4	Import Quality Check code	Text (max 4)	Mandatory. Import quality check code. It can be error codes, warning codes or information codes.
5	Import Quality Check description	Text (max 255)	Mandatory. Import quality check description. Describes the error/warning/information.
6	Field checked	Text (max 100)	Mandatory if the feedback category is 1 or 2. Field where the error was found.
